The Trust Deed of Te Nehenehenui establishes a Te Rōpū Kaumātua. It may be eligible for an annual distribution or grant for the carrying out of purposes provided in the Trust Deed for Te Nehenehenui and/or charitable purposes.

Only one distribution is available for Te Rōpū Kaumātua up to the maximum amount allowed, within the Te Nehenehenui financial year, which is 1 April to 31 March.

Grant payments are paid quarterly in June, September, December, and March.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Applicants/Office Holders must be registered on the Maniapoto Membership Register.
- Completed applications must be received within the application period.
- Funding must be used for expenses directly associated to the purposes set out in the Te Nehenehenui Trust Deed and/or charitable purposes set out in the Charities Act 2005.
- The Chairperson and one other member must authorise the application in the declaration set out in this form.
- Only one distribution per calendar year, per grant type.
